Pregnant persons who have Medicaid can continue receiving care for up to a year after pregnancy

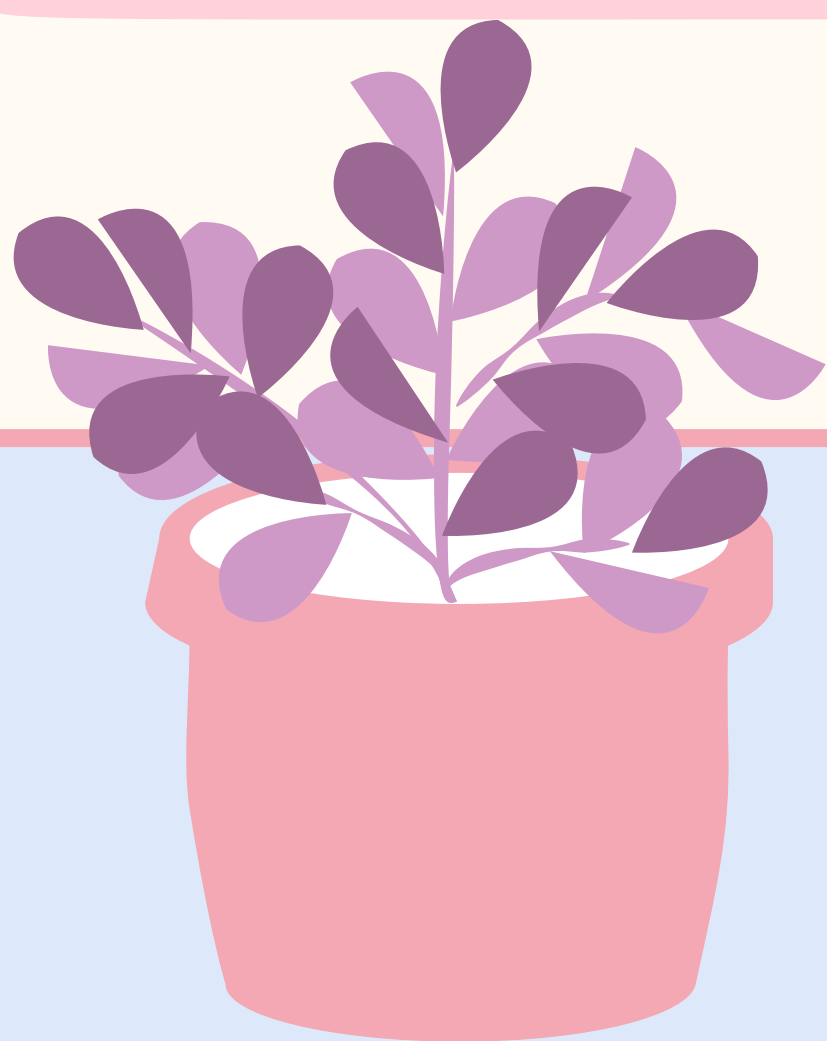
