

## **Opportunities to Support Breastfeeding** Mothers and Newborns Affected by Opioids (MNO)

Breastfeeding during COVID is possible if you wear a mask, wash hands before and after, and routinely clean and disinfect surfaces (CDC, 2020) Model of the surface of the

Mothers are eligible to breastfeed while taking the following medications (ABM 2015):

- *MAT therapy (Subutex, Buprenorphine, Suboxone, Methadone)*
- Oxycodone (prescription only)
  Hydrocodone (prescription only)

Substance use is not necessarily a contraindication to breastfeeding (WHO, 2014)

- Lorazepam (prescription only)
- SSRIs (citalopram (celexa), escitalopram (lexapro), fluoxetine (prozac), fluvoxamine (luvox), paroxetine (paxil), sertraline (zoloft)

Encouraging breastfeeding will help optimize nonpharmological care for newborns with NAS (ILPQC, 2020)
