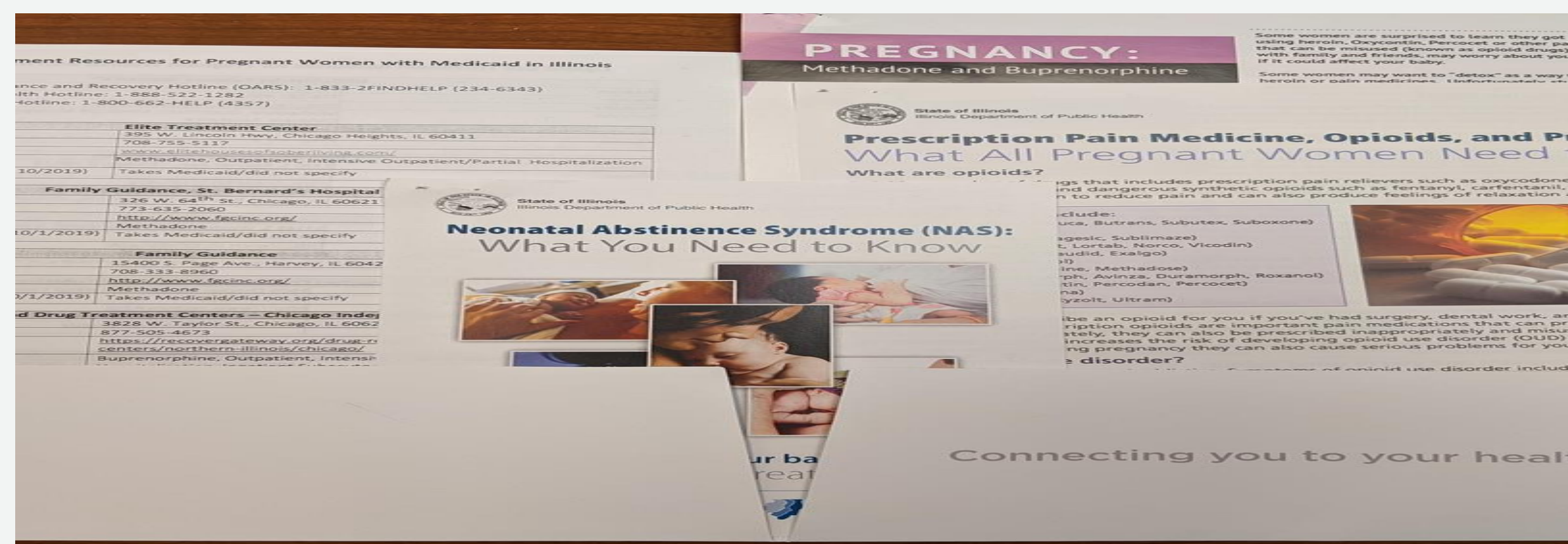
Screening Tools

- 5 P's screening tool adopted system wide.

OB providers were informed in formal OB meetings of the MNO initiative and provided with literature for patients and providers.

We have engaged the largest OB provider group by collaborating with their MD's, nurses and social worker. They utilize the 5-P screening tool as well as provide the materials used in our hospital MNO-OB packet. Going forward we plan on-site visits to the remaining private OB groups in order to facilitate their participation. We have over 25 private groups, so this is a work in progress as time and resources allow.

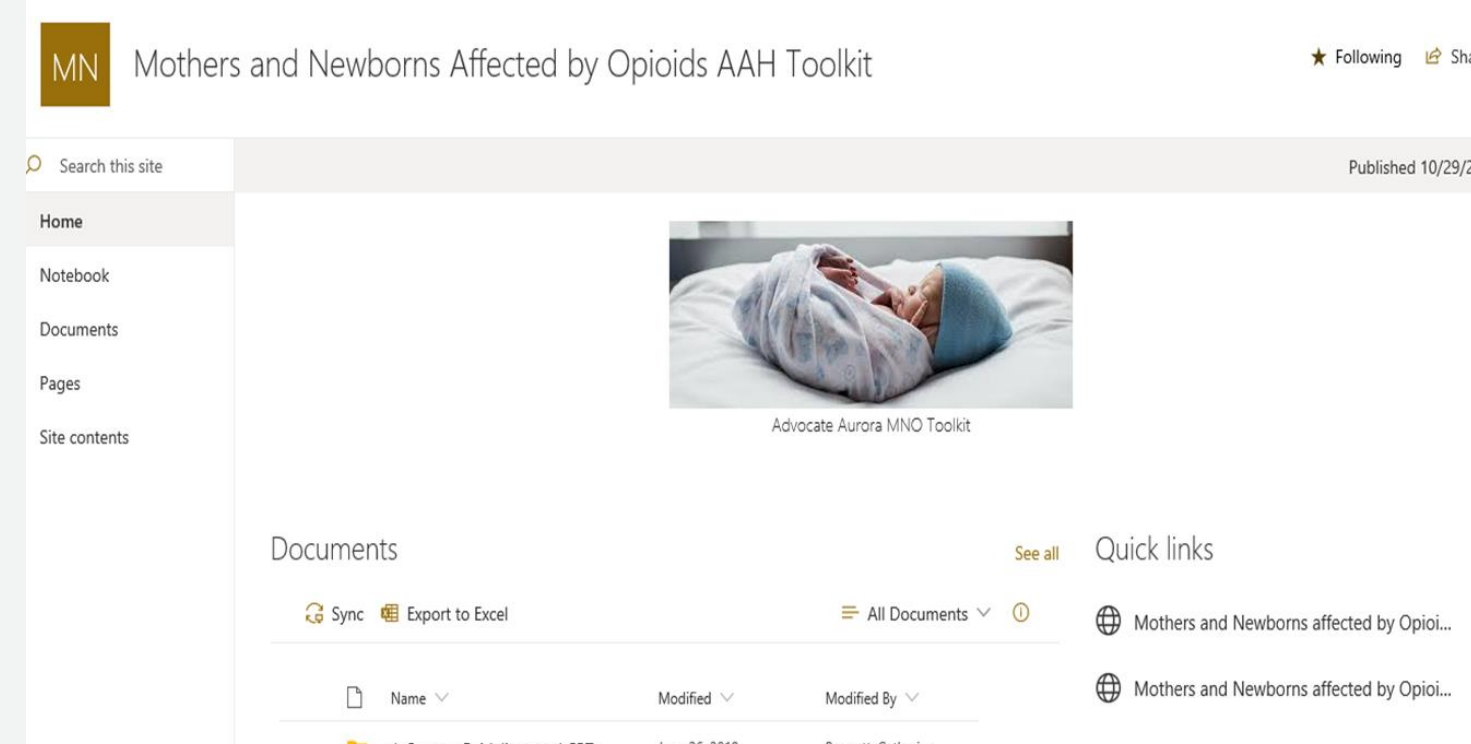

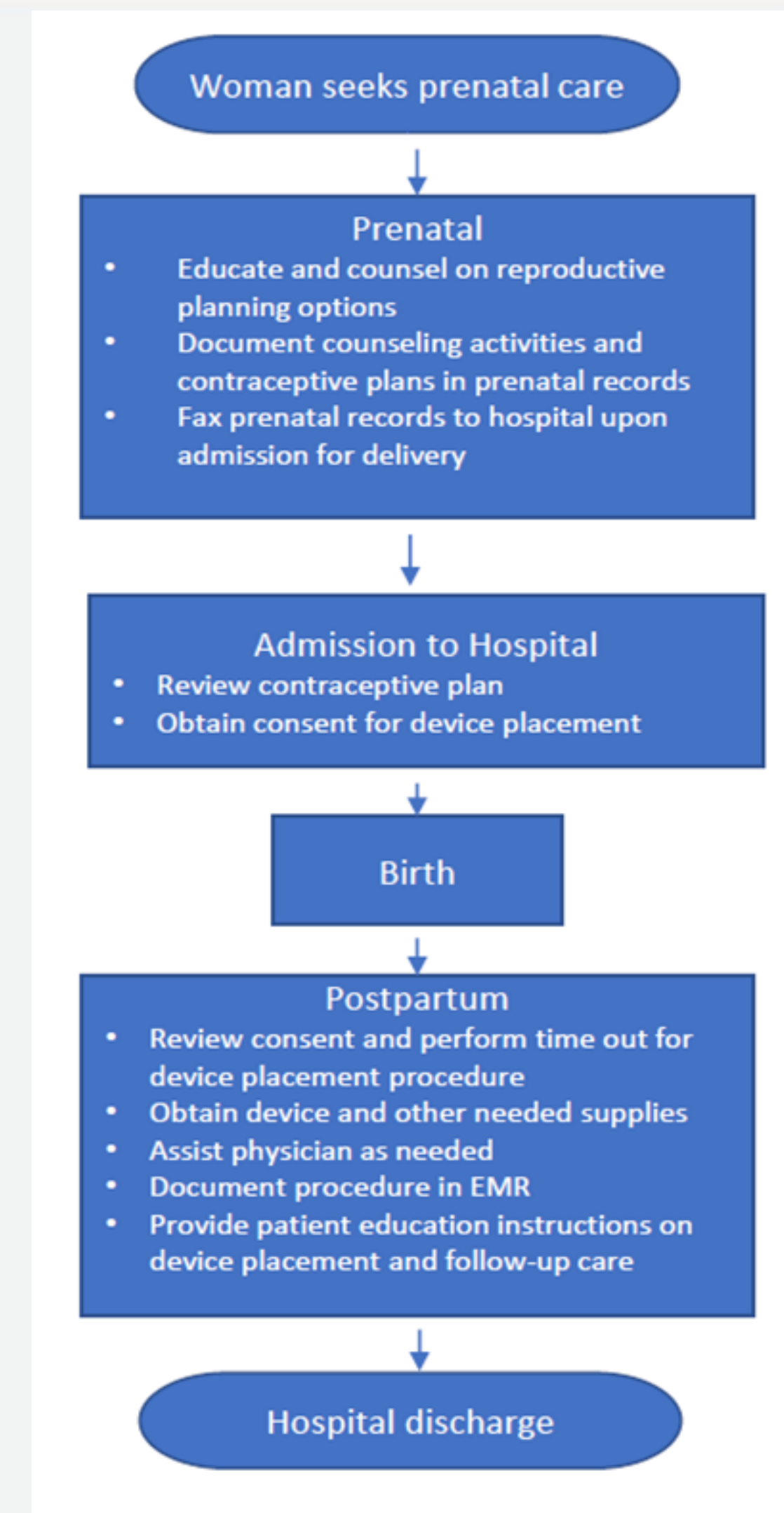
- Initially education was brought to OB department meetings and nursing unit meetings

Draft 30/60/90-day plan PVB

30 day

- Meet and greet with roles defined
- Review current practices which promote vaginal birth
- Explore system level plans for implementation and training
- Create a survey for L&D RN's to determine understanding of PVB and current interventions used to promote vaginal birth

60 Day

- Work with MD champion, CNM and Ob chairman to develop plans for provider side of initiative
- Review SMFM and ACOG guidelines and current medical literature to benchmark needs in the department
- Distribute RN survey
- Reach out to nurse educators within the system to collaborate on sharing of training and educational resources
- Explore the use of simulation scenarios for education purposes
