WHO?

All hospital teams are encouraged to submit an abstract on complete or in-progress perinatal QI work. We especially encourage hospitals that have not previously submitted an abstract, including Level I and Level II hospitals, to submit an abstract this year!

WHAT?

- Your abstract briefly describes your QI work and will be the foundation for a poster that your team creates to display and share at the ILPQC 8th Annual Conference Poster Session.

- Top abstract(s) in each submission category (OB, Neonatal, Patient/Family Engagement, and First Time Level I/II Hospital) will receive Abstract of Excellence Awards

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- o Two OB abstracts will receive special recognition, one each for (1) Best Use of Data, (2) Best Project Implementation

- o Two Neonatal QI will receive special recognition, one each for (1) Best Use of Data, (2) Best Project Implementation

HOW?

Abstract Submission Instructions:

1. Please submit your written abstract using the submission form below.

2. Abstracts should be no more than 300 words

3. Please format your abstract using the following sections:

- Problem

- Project Implementation

- Results

- Conclusions

- Please write using complete sentences and paragraph form

4. After you've submitted your abstract, your team can begin to develop a poster (see below)

Abstracts:

- Abstracts submitted in each category by midnight on Friday, October 9th will be considered for an award and blindly reviewed for excellence on predetermined criteria by a panel of reviewers.
- Abstracts submitted after Friday, October 9th, but before Friday, October 23th will be considered Late Breaking Abstracts.
- All submitted abstracts submitted will be accepted, but only those submitted before Friday, October 9th will be considered for an Award of Excellence.

Poster Development:

o o After you've submitted your abstract, your team can begin to develop a poster to be displayed on the ILPQC 8th Annual Conference Webpage. Posters must be submitted as a PDF to info@ilpqc.org by October 23rd, 2020 at midnight to be displayed.

o An abstract poster template is included for you to develop your poster.

o Please email poster as a PDF file no later than 10/23 at midnight to info@ilpqc.org to be included on the Annual Conference website.

o Please label your abstract poster PDF file extension as 2020Abstract_Institution_Date

o Graphs and tables created in PowerPoint, Excel, Visio and Word should be copied and pasted directly into the template and 'embedded'.
