


Women & Infants COVID-19 Flow Chart



*****L&D ATTENDING, FELLOW, APN SHOULD DISCUSS WHO WILL ATTEND COVID DELIVERIES AT THE START OF EACH SHIFT*****

NICU COVID Jeopardy Attending should be notified of likely SLCH COVID Admissions whenever possible.



- Pages regarding COVID-19 deliveries at BJH South (8200/8400/etc) will go to "Team Delivery: Team Peds".
- **USE CODE WORD: "DELIVERY" TO GET BEYOND 2ND FLOOR SECURITY.**
- Pages regarding COVID-19 deliveries at PVT will be "Team Delivery: Team Peds".
- Peds Team should know where the Positive or PUI are located.
- Pages regarding COVID-19 deliveries from the ER with start with: "COVID-19 RULE OUT _____"

Teams PEDS/Team Delivery Page Received to NRT/PEDS

APN/NRT Notifies PEDS Fellow Regarding Delivery

Infant EXPECTED to meet 6800 criteria

NICU Fellow/NP notifies NICU Transport RN if Delivery site is BJH COVID unit or BJH ED

If 5800 delivery, follow procedure for 6800 COVID admission

Baby is Delivered

Infant DOES meet 6800 criteria

Non-contaminated Team member Notifies 6800 of admission

CALL 6800 CN (314) 536-7484

Baby transported to 6800; Cohorted with COVID +/-PUI babies

NICU Fellow/NP calls Children's Direct to Activate TEAM COVID Delivery

GIVE MATERNAL NAME; LOCATION, GA IF AVAILABLE

CD sends group page to: NICU CN, NICU Transport, NICU Transport RT, Unit Secretary and provides info to Fellow

****This is the same group as TEAM NICU Delivery**

CD notifies COVID social worker for any COVID admission

COVID SW: 314-215-7725

Baby is Delivered

Non-contaminated Team member calls NICU CN for Disposition

NICU CN calls Transport RT with Respiratory needs

NICU Transport RN to call Security Charge and Accepting COVID Unit CN when en route

Baby transported to SLCH COVID SITE

*****TRANSPORT RN AND RT SHOULD BRING ISOLETTE AND RESPIRATORY EQUIPMENT IF NEEDED TO THE DELIVERY SITE. THEY SHOULD NOT ENTER THE ROOM UNLESS NEEDED.*****



Tent Risk Category Guide



Risk Category Workflow

High Risk (1)

No other more likely explanation:
Patient is Person Under Investigation (PUI)

Patient requires further evaluation:

- Has other chief complaint
- Concerning vital signs:
 - O2 sat <95%
 - RR >20
 - HR > 90
 - SBP <90

- Treat symptoms
 - Hydrate
 - Tylenol 1g PO if febrile
 - Zofran for nausea
- Evaluate fetus
 - NST vs BPP vs doptones

1 hour of monitoring max

- Patient afebrile
- No concerning vital signs
- Appropriate fetal surveillance reassuring
- Can tolerate PO

No

Yes

- Please refer to tent testing algorithm (side 6)
- Confirm accurate/reliable contact information
- Discharge home

Intermediate Risk (2)

Patient is not yet PUI, but has increased risk to become one

Keep mask on and proceed to 5800 if other evaluation needed

Low Risk (3)

Patient is not PUI and not at increased risk to become one

Keep mask on and proceed to 5800 if other evaluation needed

Unknown Risk (4)

Patient is not PUI and needs further evaluation

Keep mask on and proceed to 5800 if other evaluation needed

- Keep Mask On
- Call L&D Charge Nurse & MFM Fellow phone



Tent Testing Algorithm



OB COMM CENTER PRE-ADMIT COVID SCREENING

OB COMM CENTER calls all patients 2-3 days prior to scheduled delivery

- Having fevers/chills *or*
- New respiratory symptoms in last 7d

Any other new symptoms

- Upper back/shoulder blade pain
- Body/muscle ache
- Loss of smell or taste
- Vomiting or Diarrhea

Any high risk exposures

- Known exposure to +COVID person within 14d
- Been outside St. Louis area in last 14d
- Have not been social distancing in last 14d
- Someone in household sick

Usual pre-admission instructions, no further actions needed

Direct patient to WAC tent for COVID-19 evaluation and possible testing ASAP



Inform on-call physician for patient's primary OB

Inform WAC tent patient coming for evaluation with upcoming scheduled delivery


ED Delivery of COVID+ or PUI mom

Pre-arrival:

- OB and Pediatrics to bring head and face PPE **and don prior to entry to ED**– “to go bag” on L&D
- ORANGE STICKERS goes on hair bouffant



- Ohio table will be brought into room. Placed as far away from OB patient as possible while still allowing for table to be used appropriately.
- Pediatric crash cart should not be brought into the room. (Have outside room for any necessary items to be obtained). Peds will bring their own supplies into room.
- Bring smaller airway cover box (both if available, one to place over baby if intubation of mom/baby needed)



ED Delivery of COVID+ or PUI mom

Delivery:

- One nurse and one physician from each team (OB/Peds) will don gown and gloves. They will then enter room. Delivery to be performed by 1 ED MD and 1 OB MD unless more help needed.
- All other team members will be present in the doorway.
- Once need for additional staff established they will don appropriate PPE.
- After delivery, remove as many personnel as possible to limit exposure. Pull drape if possible.

Intubation:

- Only essential staff to remain in room, this would typically be the ED attending, a respiratory therapist and an ED nurse to push medications.

Trauma Anesthesia:

- If needed (for epidural etc) - Direct number is 314 747 4363

ED Delivery of COVID+ or PUI mom

Team work and communication:

- Labels to be worn by all present.
- Use closed loop communication
- May need to speak up as extra noise present due to HEPA filters
- Possibly designate one person outside of the room to be the "go between for communication"

ED team will call COVID attending to call report

- Two team member transport.
- Team member 1: is wearing appropriate PPE in case contact with patient is required
- Team member 2: is clean to push all buttons on elevators
- Patient is either masked or intubated

Process to obtain expressed breast milk from COVID+/PUI mom

- Meet mom in designated drop-off point outside the hospital (SLCH: outside front circle)
- Staff member who collects milk should wear gloves and facemask
- Staff member should have milk bottles dumped into larger plastic bag for transport back to Nursery
- Bottles should be wiped thoroughly with wipes from gray-topped container or suitable substitute and stored according to local process
