ACOG/SMFM Criteria PVB Cesarean Decision Checklist

Use this checklist with the appropriate care team members to assist in determining if ACOG/SMFM Criteria have been met, prior to delivery decision.

Cervix <6cm

Oxytocin administered for at least 12-18 hours after membrane rupture, without achieving cervical change and regular contractions

A longer duration of the latent phase (up to 24 hours or longer if maternal and fetal statuses permit)

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For inductions, c/s due to arrest <6cm, active labor has not been achieved, consider giving more time

Cervix ≥ 6cm	Сe
 Membranes ruptured + No cervical change after at least 4 hours of adequate uterine activity (e.g. strong to palpation or MVUs > 200), or at least 6 hours of oxytocin administration with inadequate uterine activity 	



rvix **10cm**/pushing

For nulliparous: Was there 3hr or more of active oushing (4hr with epidural)?

OR

For multiparous: Was here 2 hr or more of active oushing (3hr with epidural)?
