Medicaid Payment for Doula Services

Illinois Medicaid is implementing plans to reimburse doula services provided by certified doulas during pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum with additional quality incentives to doulas for facilitation of and attendance at postpartum visits and the first newborn visit. SIU School of Medicine administers the Illinois Medicaid-Certified Doula Program and is a resource for doulas and doula training agencies to meet certification requirements.

Doulas can:

- Provide information to support shared decision making during pregnancy, labor & delivery and postpartum
- Help explain the patient's <u>birth plan</u> and advocate for their emotional and physical needs to hospital staff
- Offer physical comfort through activities like massage and focused breathing
- Guide and support patient's family and loved ones
- Help with <u>breastfeeding</u>

Doulas do not provide medical advice, but they are part of the care team and their role is an important one. They provide continuous support and encouragement during labor and delivery and can help patients have a better pregnancy, birthing and postpartum experience.
