Tips for Distinguishing Public vs. Private:

1. Look for 'Medicaid' or 'HealthChoice Illinois' in the plan name. These are Public plans.
2. Check if the plan is connected to Medicare & Medicaid (MMAI). These are Public.
3. Review the card for language like 'Community Health,' 'Medicaid,' 'MMAI,' or 'CountyCare.' These are Public products.
4. Employer / Marketplace language indicates Private. PPO, HMO, or employer/marketplace coverage are usually Private.
5. Some insurers appear in both categories (e.g., Aetna, Blue Cross, Molina, Humana). **Confirm if labeled Medicaid/MMAI (Public) or Commercial/Employer (Private).**
