

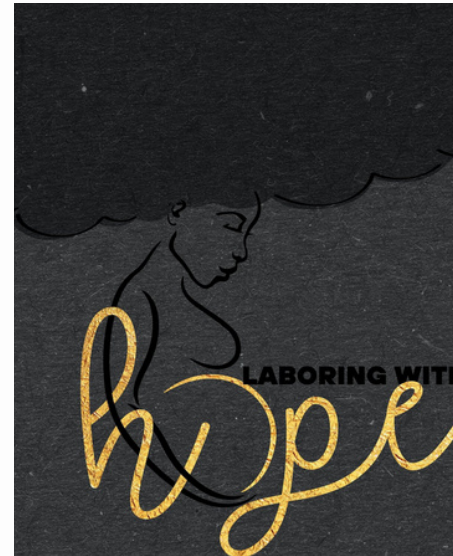

A growing body of research shows that Black women and their babies have worse health outcomes than their White counterparts, regarding pregnancy related complications. Many of these complications are preventable.

Laboring with Hope is a short documentary about loss, grief, and the hope for change. The documentary provides the backdrop for improving health outcomes for Black women and their babies. A discussion guide is included with the film as well.
